TO STRUM

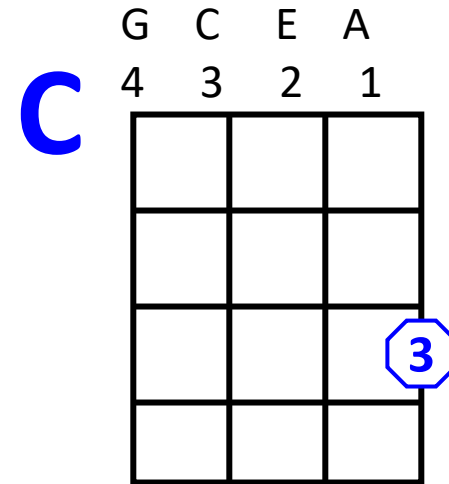
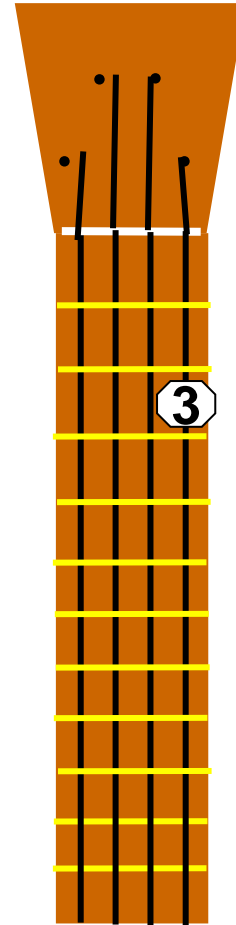
Move the index (Number 1) FINGER of your RIGHT HAND Down the strings

To make a “C” CHORD

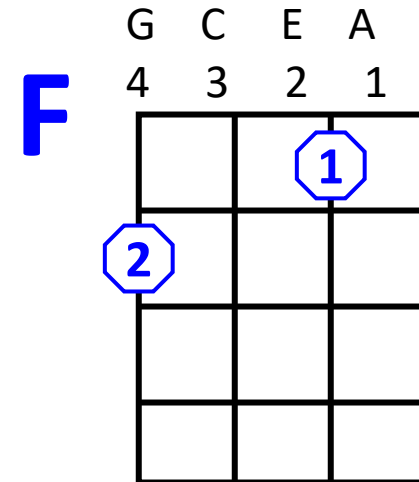
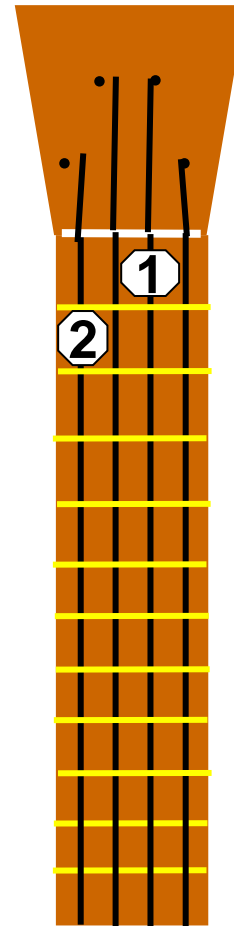
**Place your number 3

To make an “F” CHORD

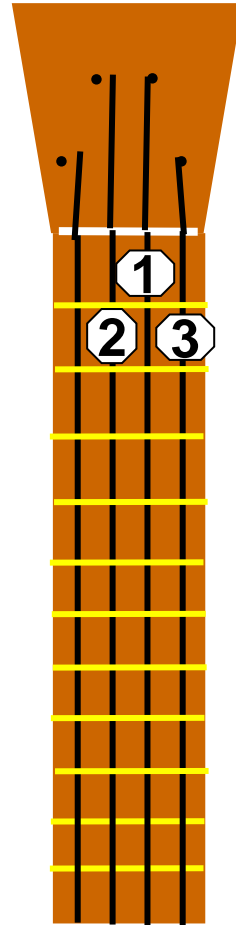
**Place your number 1
finger on the first fret of
the second string and
your number 2 finger
on the second fret of
the fourth string
(left hand)**



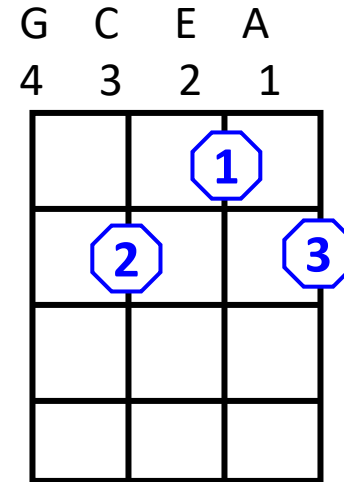
“G7” CHORD

To make a “G7” CHORD

Place your number 1 finger on the first fret of the second string, your number 2 finger on the second fret of the third string and your number 3 finger on the second fret of the first string (left hand)



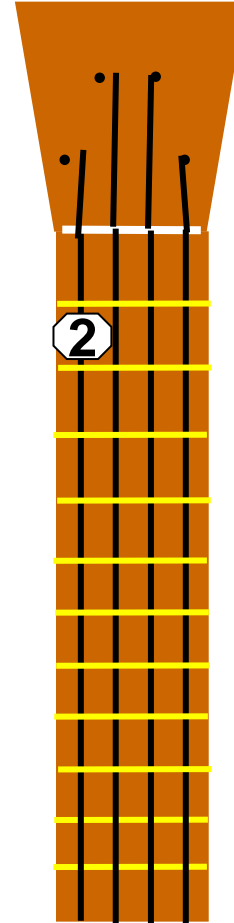

of the fourth string
(left hand)



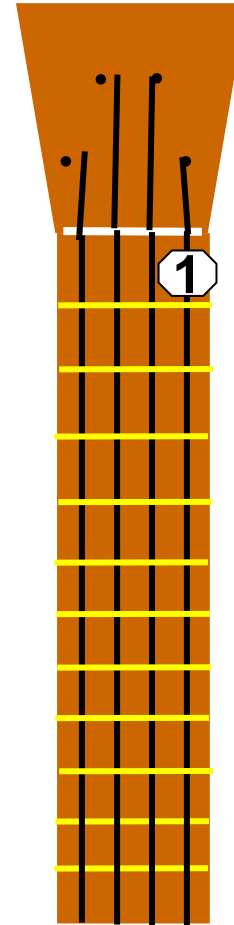

(left hand)



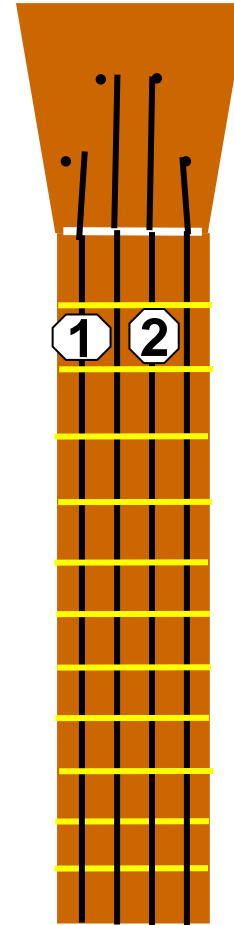

Place your number 1 finger on the second fret of the fourth string, and your number 2 finger on the second fret of the second string (left hand)



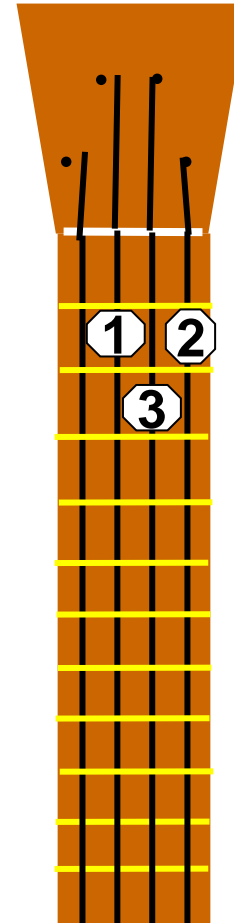

Place your number 1 finger on the second fret of the third string, your number 2 finger on the second fret of the first string and your number 3 finger on the third fret of the second string (left hand)



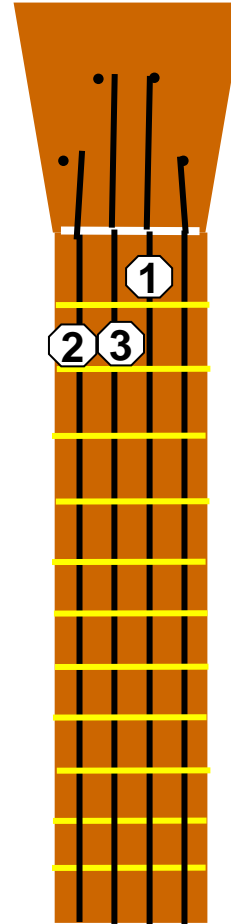
